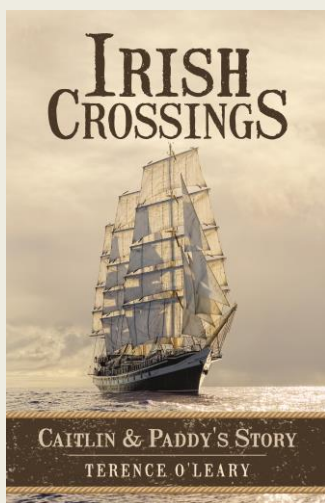
A Christmastime dinner conversation about his ancestors led author Terence O'Leary on a four year journey to write historical novels:

Irish Crossings – Caitlin & Paddy's Story and Irish Crossings – Danny's Story

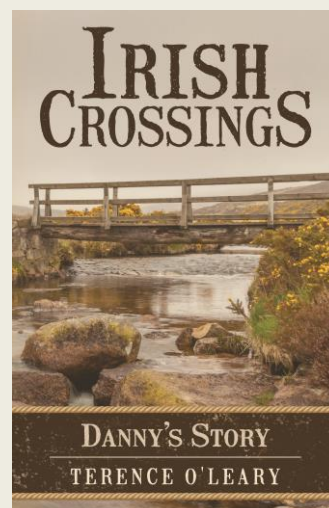
Mr. O'Leary has woven his historical research into a 45 minute presentation on The Great Hunger:

Ireland awoke to the beginning of the Great Hunger in 1845. Experience the heartbreaking stories of the Irish during the five long years of the Potato Famine. While it was a time of great injustice when more than one million Irish died, it also became a tragic blessing for over one million Irish who fled to America and survived.



Mr. O'Leary has given his Great Hunger presentation at numerous Irish Festivals including the Irish Festivals in Dublin, Dayton, Pittsburgh and Detroit. The author/speaker has lectured at libraries and universities about the tragic Potato Famine and how it changed the destiny not only of Ireland, but also America.
